As a part of peer lead team activity, a workshop “Code Fusion” was conducted by students of B.E. E & TC, Arya Danech as team leader along with Avadhoot Kulkarni and Apoorva Bedade for S.E., T.E. and B.E. students. The peer lead team had the primary objective of providing an overview of open source contributions. The workshop emphasized the installation and use of Git and GitHub for coders as well as non-coders. The workshop started after the address by HOD, Dr. S.P. Agnihotri, who explained the peer lead team activity objectives and importance to the students. Around 35 students participated in this workshop. Following topics were covered in the workshop :
